Spring Lake frenzy over sighting of endangered honeyeater

SPRINGFIELD resident and amateur bird expert Peter Gelding thought it would be just another day at the lake documenting a few bird sightings — and then he heard an unusual call.

Every month Mr Gelding spends a day at Spring Lake

counting ducks for Birdlife Queensland, but on June 24 he saw a flash of yellow in a Moreton Bay Fig tree that has changed his life.

He grabbed his best lens and took a near-perfect photo of one of Australia's most endangered and

beautiful birds — the Regent Honey Eater.

Just to be sure, he uploaded his precious photo to the Birdlife Australia Bird ID and got an instant response—there could be not doubt it was the shy and fast moving honey eater.

Gelding's photo has created a storm of interest with birdwatchers from around Australia staking out Springfield in the hope of t catching a glimpse of the honey eater.
